TYPE OF CONSTRUCTION

Price Electric's employees went to work on the city's damaged infrastructure after the Derecho ripped across town. Multiple temporary span wire traffic signals were put up with no engineering provided. General knowledge of IMSA, SUDAS & Cedar Rapids city standards were used to determine all aspects of installations.

BUILDING FEATURES

With no power available from the utility company, large traffic jams at each intersection and scarce materials, the team at Price Electric went to work to get damaged infrastructure functioning and facilitate repairs throughout the city. Each Price employee worked 14 straight days in the middle of summer from sunup to sundown for a total of 1,000 manhours in the 16-day timespan.
